During my two weeks visit in Lund University, we had several interesting discussions with my host Tommy Andersson. I had the opportunity to give a seminar talk where I presented my recent work with Bettina Klaus on object allocation problems, where we are trying to understand the desirable properties that characterize a common real life object allocation mechanism, called the immediate acceptance mechanism, and also trying to understand how that mechanism can be extended to the object allocation problems where there are diversity concerns. During and after my talk, I received very valuable feedback that significantly improved our paper. I also had a chance to discuss my ongoing projects with several other faculty members such as Jens Gudmundsson.
