Title: "The return of logic to epistemology"

Epistemic logic and epistemology were close in those exciting days when modern modal and epistemic logic first came onto the philosophical scene in the 1960s. But over the decades, the two areas have started moving apart, despite the valiant efforts of conferences like TARK gathering philosophers, logicians, computer scientists and economists in secluded settings. In this talk, I discuss how modern dynamic-epistemic logics for interactive information flow shed light on old discussions about verificationism, and might even affect the agenda of epistemology.
